Slacker?

While studying the book of Proverbs in my small group Bible study, our Leader suggested that we change the description of a lazy person from a sluggard to a slacker. Ah, now he was speaking my lingo. I immediately started thinking of all the people I consider to be slackers.

Like the men and women who fail to teach and discipline their children. Or that guy who refuses to help around the house. Or those teenagers who neglect their studies and play Internet games day and night.

If were honest, we're all susceptible to this. What about being a "prayer slacker," or a Bible reading slacker," or a "non-exercising-of our-spiritual-gift slacker," or a "non- witnessing slacker"?

If we are not doing what we know God wants us to do, we are certainly spiritual slackers. In fact, when we refuse to obey God, we are sinning.

Listen to these challenging and convicting words from the book of James: "It is sin to know what you ought to do and then no do it". Let's not be spiritual slackers.

When we know what God wants us to do, but then we refuse to obey, we're ignoring the voice of the Lord, and sinfully choosing our way.

"Insight"

The Bible often uses animals as illustrations to describe people or human behaviors. In the book of Proverbs, common animals like deer, gazelle, bird, ox, pig, horse, donkey, dog, lamb, goat, lion and bear are mentioned. The largest concentration of animal imagery is found in Agur's wise sayings. The ant is mentioned twice, here in 6:6 and 30:25, to donate a wise person. The wise are righteous, responsible, enterprising and hard working. In contrast, sluggards are fools who lack initiative, procrastinate, are irresponsible and are self-deceived.
